Karuna Master Symbols

The Karuna Reiki® Master symbols are used in other healing systems. For example The International Center for Reiki Training uses the Usui Dai Ko Myo, Tibetan Dai Ko Mio and the Tibetan Fire Serpent in our Usui/Tibetan Reiki Master Training. The Usui Dai Ko Myo and Tibetan Symbols are used in the Karuna system to act as a bridge from the Usui and Tibetan systems into the Karuna system.


When using these first three symbols in combination (Om, Dai Ko Mio, Fire Serpent) while channeling Karuna Reikio, they take on a vibration that is unique to the Karuna Reikio energy.

The Karuna® Reiki Master symbols can empower the hands before treatments and attunements by placing these three symbols in the palms of the hands. One would place Om in the hands, repeat the name 3 times silently, and clap the hands together, or pat the palms three times. Repeat this process with the Tibetan Dai Ko Mio, and Fire Serpent.

Tibetan Master Symbol Dai Ko Mio

This symbol is used to begin the attunement process. It is used with the violet breath, and during treatments. When used with the Karuna Reikie energy Dai Ko Mio flows through the recipient connecting

them to Mother Earth at the Earth star chakra. Thus it assists one in being centered and grounded in their spiritual purpose.



Tibetan Fire Serpent

This symbol is used during the attunement process to join the chakras in preparation for the attunement. It is drawn with the arch over the crown and the serpent going down the spine and spiraling at the base. It can be used to join the chakras during a treatment or meditation. When used with Karuna Reiki® energy it aligns all the chakras and the energy bodies simultaneously. This prepares the recipient for the depth of the Karuna Reiki® energy.



Om

This is a Sanskrit symbol and is used in many eastern spiritual practices. It symbolizes the oneness that we are and connects us to it. Purifies, protects, seals and stabilizes the Aura. Opens the crown and when drawn above one's head, opens a pathway to God and higher consciousness.
